


Block of the Month 2024

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February

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	8" Block (8 ½" unfinished)	16" Block (16 ½" unfinished)
Medium (A)	(4) 1 ½″ squares	(4) 2 ½″ squares
Medium (B)	(1) 2″ square	(1) 3″ square
Medium (C)	(2) 1 ½″ squares	(2) 2 ½″ squares
Light (D)	(4) 1 ½" x 2 ½" rectangles	(4) 2 ½" x 4 ½" rectangles
Light (E)	(4) 1 ½″ squares	(4) 2 ½″ squares
Light (F)	(1) 2″ square	(1) 3″ square


Designer Note: Follow the block guide shown for fabric placement. Units are labeled A-F.

## **Piecing Instructions**

- 1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (4) A squares using an erasable marker or pencil.
- 2. Place (1) A square onto the corner of (2) D rectangles, right sides together.
- 3. Sew along the drawn diagonal lines as shown. Trim the excess corner fabric to a ¼" and press toward the corners.
- Repeat stitch and flip techniques to attach an additional A square to the adjacent corner of each D rectangle to complete (2) flying geese units.
- 5. Use the following guide for flying geese unit sizes for 8" and 16" blocks:
  - a. 8" Block:  $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished.
  - b. 16" Block: 2  $\frac{1}{2}$  x 4  $\frac{1}{2}$  unfinished.




- 6. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) F square using an erasable marker or pencil.
- 7. Place (1) F square with (1) B square, right sides together.
- 8. Sew a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from both sides of the drawn diagonal line.
- 9. Cut along the drawn diagonal line, making (2) HST units.
- 10. Trim HST units using the following guide for 8" and 16" blocks:
  - a. 8" Block: 1 ½" x 1 ½" unfinished.
  - b. 16" Block: 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished.




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
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- 11. Arrange the flying geese units, HST units, (2) C squares, (2) D rectangles and (4) E squares to form the February block center. Sew together, using arrows for pressing instructions.
- 12. Use the following guide for February block center sizes:
  - a. 8" Block:  $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished.
  - b. 16" Block: 8 1/2" x 8 1/2" unfinished.



13. Arrange the prepared Star Border pieces around the February block center and assemble as shown. Reference the Cutting Chart for unfinished block sizes.
