

Cutting Instructions


	8" Block (8 ½" unfinished)	16" Block (16 ½" unfinished)
Medium (A)	(1) 2" square	(1) 3" square
Medium/Dark (B)	(2) 2" squares	(2) 3" squares
Medium (C)	(2) 1 ½" squares	(2) 2 ½" squares
Medium (D)	(8) 1 ½" squares	(8) 2 ½" squares
Light (E)	(3) 2" squares	(3) 3" squares
Light (F)	(4) 1 ½" x 2 ½" rectangles	(4) 2 ½" x 4 ½" rectangles

Designer Note: Follow the block guide shown for fabric placement.

Units are labeled A-F.

Piecing Instructions

- 1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (3) E squares using an erasable marker or pencil.
- 2. Place (1) E square with each of (1) A square and (2) B squares, right sides together.
- 3. Sew a ¼" away from both sides of the drawn diagonal line on each set of squares.
- 4. Cut along the drawn diagonal lines, making a total of (2) A/E HST units and (4) B/E HST units.
- 5. Trim HST units using the following guide for 8" and 16" blocks:
 - a. 8" Block: 1½" x 1½" unfinished.
 - b. 16" Block: 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" unfinished.





- 6. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (8) D squares using an erasable marker or pencil.
- 7. Place (1) D square onto the corner of (4) F rectangles, right sides together.
- 8. Sew along the drawn diagonal lines as shown. Trim the excess corner fabric to a $\frac{1}{4}$ " and press toward the corners.
- 9. Repeat stitch and flip techniques to attach an additional D square to the adjacent corner of each F rectangle to complete (4) flying geese units.
- 10. Use the following guide for flying geese unit sizes for 8" and 16" blocks:
 - a. 8" Block: 1½" x 2½" unfinished.
 - b. 16" Block: 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" unfinished.
















- 11. Arrange (2) A/E HST units and (2) C squares to form the 4-patch unit. Sew together, pressing away from the HST units.
- 12. Use the following guide for 4-patch unit sizes for 8" and 16" blocks:
 - a. 8" Block: 2 ½" x 2 ½" unfinished.
 - b. 16" Block: 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" unfinished.







- 13. Arrange the 4-patch unit, (4) B/E HST units and (4) flying geese units to form the May block center. Sew together, pressing seams away from flying geese units.
- 14. Use the following guide for May block center sizes:
 - a. 8" Block: 4 ½" x 4 ½" unfinished.
 - b. 16" Block: 8 ½" x 8 ½" unfinished.





15. Arrange the prepared Star Border pieces around the May block center and assemble as shown. Reference the Cutting Chart for unfinished block sizes.
